The Declarations of the trails Article IV Section 4 "any such assessment shall have the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of the votes of who are voting in person or by proxy at a meeting duly called for this purpose." The Declarations of the Trails Article IV Section 5 "At the first such meeting called, the presence of members or of proxies entitled to cast sixty percent (60%) of all the votes of membership shall constitute a quorum. If the required quorum is not present, another meeting may be called subject to the same notice requirement, and the required quorum at the subsequent meeting shall be one-half (½) of the required quorum at the preceding meeting."
